

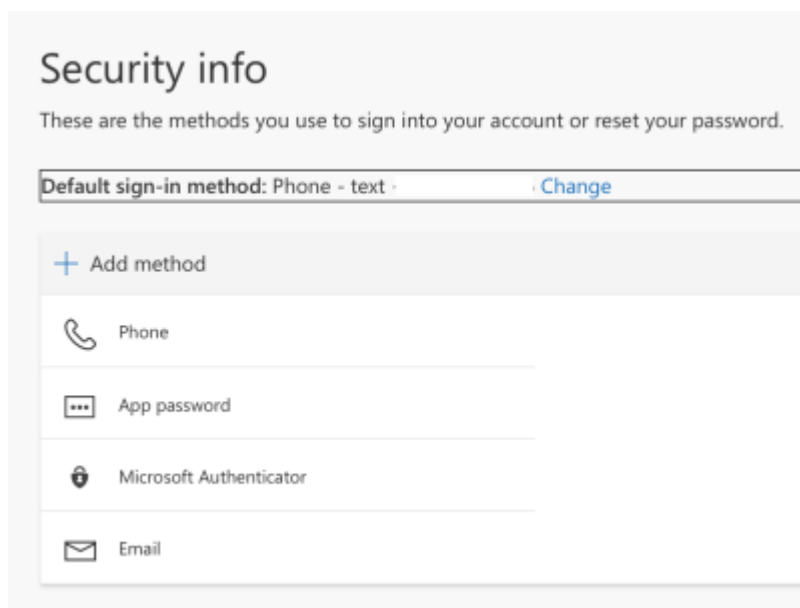

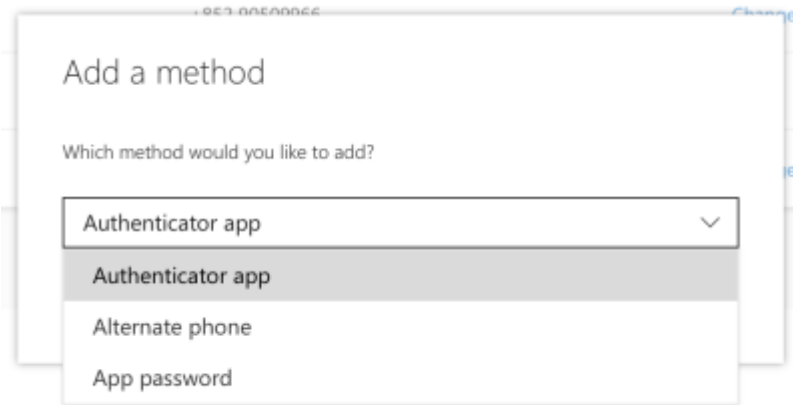

Step by Step

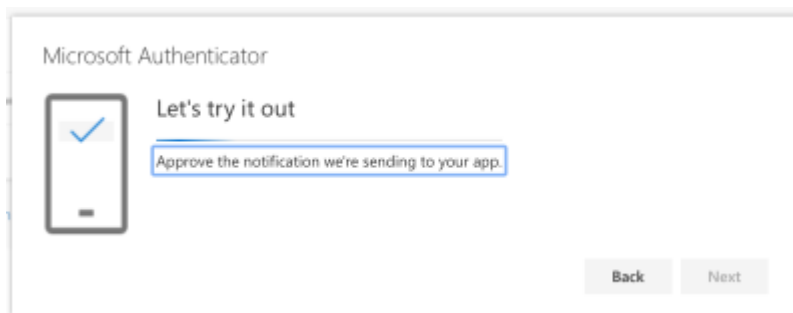
- Download and install 'Microsoft Authenticator' on your mobile phone.
- Login your Office 365
- click [View Account] on top-right
- choose [Security Info] on the left menu bar
- there is a list of your authentication methods
- check if 'Microsoft Authenticator' is listed, if not, click [Add method]



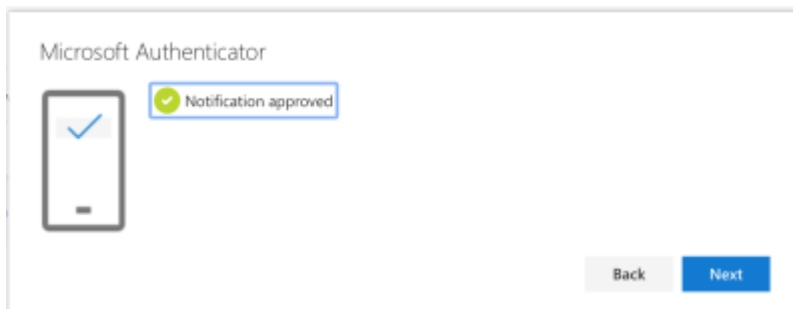
- choose 'Authenticator app'



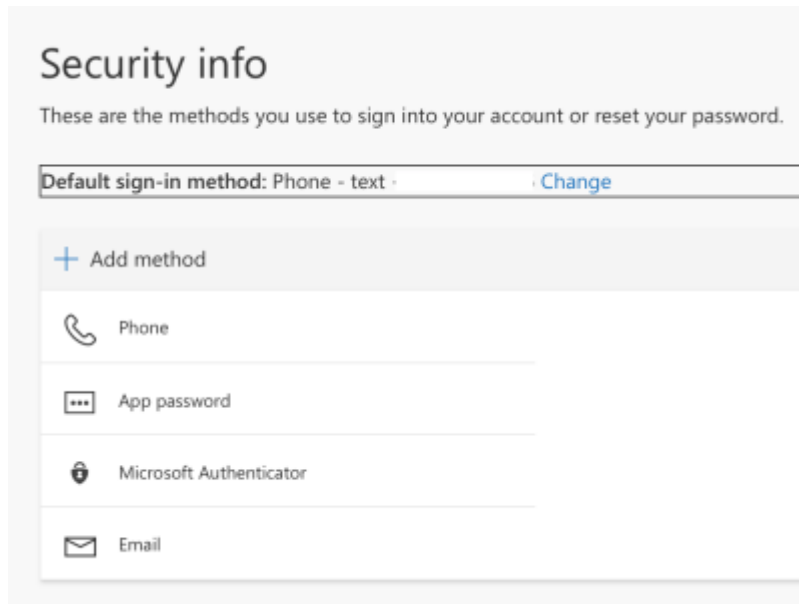
- click next a few times until you see the QR code
- scan with the microsoft authenticator app and then click next
- it will then ask you to 'approve' it on your mobile phone



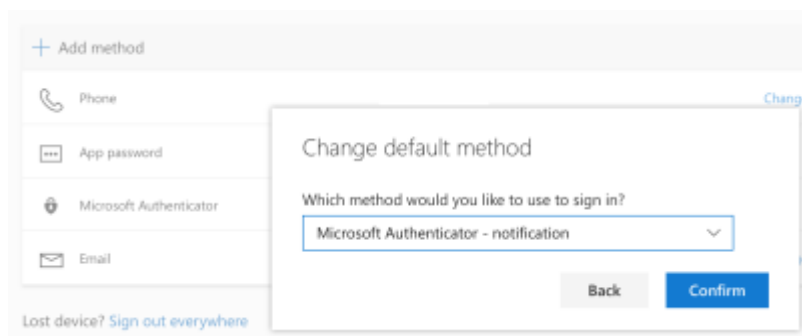
- check your mobile phone and approve it



- there should be 'microsoft authenticator' in the list



- Click the [change] button to change the 'default sign-in method' to 'Microsoft authenticator'



- Then try logout and login again, after you enter the password, it should ask you to approve it on your mobile phone

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
